Regular Council met at 8 P.M. with W.P. Eld Mayor in Chair upon roll call the following alderman responded  
Alderman Lewis. Dickerson. Hodgecock. McKinney. Ranney  
Wyer Whorton and Starr

Minutes of June 7<sup>th</sup> read and approved.

The report of City Treasurer for month of May was read and referred to Finance Committee.

The report of City Marshall for month of May was read and referred to Finance Committee.

Alderman Wyer made verbal report he had with the Committee appointed, met with the Volunteer Fire Dept to try and agree upon Ordinance # 77 concerning Fire Department, he reported they could not agree.

The following communication was read.

To The Committee of City Alderman of the City of Grand Junction  
Gentlemen:- At a meeting of the Grand Junction Volunteer Fire Department held Wednesday evening June 8<sup>th</sup> 1898  
it was:

Resolved, - That in the event of a strained relation existing between the City Council and this Department and the main feature of the said event seemingly being the electing or appointing of the City Hall Janitor and City Peanster, that this Department concedes to the election or appointing of the City Peanster and Janitor by the City Council and request of their honorable Body that they concede to this Department running as fire-to-fire under the Volunteer Ordinance; and that they appropriate each year to the Volunteer Department the amount set aside to run the proposed paid Fire Department; the appropriation to be used by the Department as they so wish or saw fit Very Respt. John Byrne  
Chief For The Department.

Alderman Dickerson made motion to reconsider ordinance # 77. Concerning Fire Department

The vote was as follows upon roll call. Alderman Lewis. Ranney, Wyer, Whorton and Starr voting Nay, Alderman Dickerson, Hodgecock and McKinney voting yea. The motion was lost.

The Finance Committee made favorable report on City Treasurer report for month of April 1898

Upon motion by Alderman Lewis check was instructed to draw a warrant for \$31.20 to pay balance due on Flag and pole which was erected in Lathamwood Park June 14<sup>th</sup> 1898

The Flag Committee presented Flag & Pole to City where on the Mayor thanked said Committee, upon roll call all old voted yea in motion
