

Grand Juror Calc. June 16<sup>th</sup> 1898

City Council met pursuant to adjournment with Mayor W. B. Ela in Chair. Roll Call showed the following Alderman present + Currie, Haddock, Whorton, Ramey, Weyer and Starr + Minutes of June 14<sup>th</sup> read and approved + a petition for a side walk to be built on Third Street before Blocks 124 & 141 Lots # 1 & 32 Block 124 & 141 was read. Same was signed by A. T. Anderson & 8 others + same was referred to the Street & Alley Committee

The said Committee made a favorable report.

on motion by Alderman Haddock a side walk was ordered to be laid on west side of Lot 1 in Block 141 and City Engineer paving Street crossing to same, and City Marshal notified of same and City Hall was called upon the latter motion and it was as follows. Alderman Currie + Haddock + Whorton Ramey Weyer & Starr voting yea, motion carried + a list of supplies was asked for by Junitor Barton for City Hall + upon motion same was referred to Purchasing Committee with power to act +

upon motion by Alderman Haddock. The repairs on City Jail was referred to the Fire Police Board. with power to act +

upon motion by Alderman Haddock. The Street Commissioner was instructed to set Posts in all drive ways to Cottonwood Park so as to prevent teams driving through said Park +

upon motion by Alderman Whorton Chairman of Street & Alley Committee was instructed to see C. M. White and have him comply with his contract by putting Ditches at following places in order  
Corner First & Grand Avenue + Between White and Grand Ave on East side of Fourth Street + down by the Bicycle Track

A petition from Volunteer Fire Department was read same was signed by J. B. Hyatt Chief Frank N. Haskell Arch Chief Geo. R. Garrison Foreman Hose Co. & A. Woodworth Foreman Hook and Ladder Co + and 28 members.

upon motion by Alderman Starr the petition was laid over until our next meeting and Mayor instructed to appoint a Committee of 3. to confer with the Volunteer Fire Department

The Mayor appointed an above Committee Alderman Haddock, Starr and Ramey +

upon motion by Alderman Haddock. M. M. Shores was granted privilege to erect a corrugated shed on west of north side of building on Lot 20. Block 104 City of Grand Junction upon motion by Alderman Starr the following bills were allowed and Clerk instructed to draw warrants for same +

upon motion by alderman Weyer. The Kid Band
