Upon motion by Alderman Starr The Fire & Police Board with City Atty were instructed to meet with a Committee from Fire Department to draft further ordinance covering Fire Department, which would be satisfactory to Council and Fire Department.

Alderman Starr made a verbal report that side walk on North side of main Street between 3rd and fourth Streets was in bad order. Work of Brunnerich Halls. Upon motion by Alderman Curtis Damm was referred to the Street & Alley Committee.

Upon motion by Alderman Hodgecock The City Phys: was instructed to fumigate the City Hall building as far as possible.

Upon motion by Alderman Hodgecock. The Street & Alley Committee were instructed to look after the ditches in Second ward and see if same could not be changed so as to run in some other portion of City.

Upon motion by Alderman Hodgecock. The Mayor was instructed to notify the City Marshall he must have all parties hauling Garbage. to dump same in proper place and not in Streets.

Upon motion by Alderman Hodgecock. Council adjourned to meet June 29<sup>th</sup> Tuesday Ev. at 8 P.M.
