

Grand June Co. June 28 1898

city council met pursuant to adjournment with mayor W.P. Egan in Chair. all Alderman present except Alderman McKimney. minutes of June 21<sup>st</sup> read and approved. Alderman Weyer Chairman of Fire & Police Board made report that the Fire & Police Committee had met with a committee from Fire Department and drafted a new ordinance which seems to meet with approval of all concerned. Alderman Starr made report he had made a General inspection of lots where new side walk was needed. Alderman Starr not knowing number of lots on Block's side walk was needed. The Mayor granted the Street & Alley Committee further time to make a complete report.

Alderman Currie made motion that dirt taken from grounds of A.A. Miller in Block 104 be placed upon Alley and Streets where most needed and the Street Com look after said work himself carried.

Alderman Starr reported he had taken up the Ackerman porch matter with property owners in same block and most owners objected upon motion by Alderman Starr action by Council upon same was laid over until our next meeting. The roll was call upon the motion and it was as follows Alderman Currie, Ranney and Whorton voting yea - Alderman Hodgecock, Dickerson Starr and Weyer voting yea -

Upon motion by Alderman Hodgecock Clerk was instructed to have Ackerman bring in plans of porch. Upon motion by Alderman Hodgecock the following bills were allow and Clerk instructed to draw warrant for same upon proper funds. The Roll was call on same and was as follows. Alderman Currie, Hodgecock, Dickerson Ranney Whorton and Weyer voting yea - Alderman Starr not voting #127 Abv Hayton \$ 3.00 #128 C. M. White \$ 100.00 #129 B. Mitchell \$ 2.50

upon motion by Alderman Hodgecock the rules were suspended to take action on a new Fire ordinance. The vote on same was as follows. Alderman Currie Dickerson Hodgecock, Ranney Starr Whorton and Weyer voting yea - Alderman Weyer introduced Ordinance # 78 concerning Fire Department and to repeal certain other provisions relative to the same.

upon motion by Alderman Hodgecock Fire Ordinance # 78 was taken up and passed by the following vote Alderman Currie Dickerson Hodgecock, Ranney Starr, Weyer and Whorton voting yea -

upon motion by Alderman Whorton Local Representatives of the Grand Junction Water Works Co be given notice later than our regular meeting in July to deliver title to Grand Jet Water Works and make transfer or deal with the affairs of the Grand June Water Works Co.

The vote was as follows on Whorton motion Alderman  
burie. Haddock. Dickerson. Roney. Starr. Weyer & Whorton  
voting yea::

upon motion by Alderman Haddock The Finance Com-  
was instructed to have back room of City Hall up stairs  
cleaned up and papered and same be used as a Council  
room. also committee has power to act.

The vote was as follows. Alderman burie. Dickerson  
Whorton Weyer. Roney Haddock and Starr voting yea=  
upon motion by Alderman Haddock The Fire & Police  
Board in conjunction with City Phys & Atty draw up  
an ordinance concerning Crr Pools and Vaults +

upon motion by Alderman burie no person out side  
of Councilmen shall have right of floor without  
permission of Council

The Council gave Perry Rodgers permission to speak  
Mr Rodgers made complaint of wagons burning in  
streets in front of shops which interrupted very much  
in getting fire team and wagon to a fire +

Alderman Starr made motion Fire and Police board look  
after same Alderman burie amended same that  
city Marshall look after same and have wagons and  
other stuff removed from street. Alderman burie  
motion carried +

upon motion by Alderman burie The City Marshall  
was instructed to see that all wagons & cts take the  
right side of street

upon motion by Alderman Haddock Council adjourned  
to meet next Tuesday Evening July 5<sup>th</sup> 1878 at 8 PM
