city council met pursuant to adjournment at 8 Pm with

Jos H Ramsey - Burk in Chair:
All Alderman present except alderman Hadcock & Mayor Ela.
minutes of June 28 read and approved with corrections &
upon motion by alderman Lewis minutes of June 28 were
made to read that Street Commissioner spread dirt
personally with his own labor upon the Streets & Alleys
The vote on motion was as follows Alderman Dickerson
Wyer Whorton Ramsey & Lewis voting yea & Alderman Starr
and McKinney voting nay: Carried.
upon motion by Alderman Wyer the city jail was ordered
white washed &

Alderman Starr made report that 6 lots in Block
102 along north side of main street between 3rd & 4th
streets just west of Brunswick Hotel needed new sidewalk
upon motion by alderman Lewis new sidewalk was
ordered laid in front of lots 21 to 32 inclusive in Block
102 and Street & Alley Committee furnish Council
a list of all other lots on main street between 3rd
and 7th Streets in need of new sidewalk.

The roll was called upon this motion and all aldermen
voting yea:

Alderman Wyer as Chairman Fire & Police Board ^{made report} that
the board did not wish to draw an ordinance concerning
cess pools. But desired an ordinance or Resolution
drawn covering vaults: Alderman Wyer then introduced
the following Resolution

Be it Resolved By the City Council that the city Marshall
and city Physician be and are hereby instructed to order
all vaults that have become offensive in the city cleaned
out & also that they ^{prevent} to graunt or permit the digging of new
vaults or premises which already have vaults thereon
upon motion by alderman wyer the above Resolution
was adopted by the following vote. all alderman
voting yea:

Upon motion by alderman McKinney it was ordered
that the ditch known as the Farmers Ditch cease
running water through the city limits of Grand Junction
forthwith &

Alderman Starr made motion that action on request of
Mr Ackerman for porch be laid over until next regular
meeting of Council. The roll was called upon motion &
was as follows alderman McKinney Whorton Ramsey
and Lewis voting yea. alderman Dickerson Starr
and Wyer voting yea. The motion was lost &

upon motion by alderman Whorton request of
Mr Ackerman for a porch in front of building on
lot 28 Block 103 was refused by the following vote
Alderman Dickerson McKinney Starr Wyer Whorton
Ramsey & Lewis voting yea:

also that the Fire Department be requested to hand
 into Council a list of members of Fire Department
 all Alderman voting yea on this motion
 upon motion by Alderman McKinney Communication
 read by Alderman Whorton concerning night Marshall
 was ordered thrown in waste basket

Council granted A. G. Mann Police Magistrate
 permission to speak. Mr Mann made request for
 blanks to make out his monthly reports and
 Council adjourned to meet July 12th at 8 Pm
