

Grand Juror Colo. July 12th 1898

Regular meeting of City Council met at 8 PM with Mayor W.P. Eld in Chair upon roll call all alderman were found present an motion reading of minutes of July 5th deferred with upon motion of Barnahan acted as City Clerk Pro Tem the report of Marshall Mann was received and upon motion same was accepted.

The reports of City Janitor also City Marshall was referred to Finance Committee. The Bond of Marion E. Barton in the sum of \$500.00 with Manuel E. Barton L.P. McLeary and Geo E Bates as signers was read and upon motion the Bond was accepted.

A number of Bills were read and upon motion same was referred to the Finance Committee.

A Communication from Judge Caswell relative to closing up transfer of water work was read upon motion by Alderman Godcock the Water Co was given until next Tuesday Evening to get papers here and close up the deal.

The rules were suspended and Alderman Whorton introduced the following Resolution

Whereas the City of Grand Council of the City of Grand Jet has purchased of Cyrus W. Shores certain Real Estate for the opening of Main Street and Spruce Streets and an alley according to his deed duly recorded in Book 63 at page 342 of the records of Mesa County Colorado and whereas said City Council has purchased of Joseph Bieser certain lands for the extension of Colorado Avenue through lands of Joseph Bieser which deed of Joseph Bieser is recorded in Book 63 at Page 298 of the records of Mesa County Colorado

Therefore be it resolved that said Streets and alleys be and the same are hereby declared open to use for the public for travel according to the descriptions of lands embraced in said Deeds.

Upon motion same was adopted and upon roll call Alderman voted yea on Resolution.

The Rio Grande R.R. Co submitted a new contract for a crossing across its tracks on main Street same was discussed but no action taken upon motion Council adjourned to meet Tuesday Eve
