

Grand Junction July 22nd 1898

City Council met pursuant to adjournment at 8 PM with Jas. De Ramey in Chair. and upon Roll call the following Alderman answered present + namely Currier Dickerson, Weyer, Whorton, Ramey, Starr, McKinney City Clerk DeLoplain being absent on account of sickness it was moved and seconded that J. S. Barnahan act as Clerk Pro Tem. motion put and carried Minutes of July 19th read and approved + upon motion by Alderman Whorton the regular order of Business was dispersed with and Council took up ordinance # 29.

Ays Starr, Hadcock and McKinney. Nays Judge Caswell was granted privilege to address Council on the passage of ordinance # 29. and the transfer of Water Co plant.

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1 Alderman Starr made motion to lay over the passage of Ordinance # 29 until our regular meeting in Aug - Ross Alderman Whorton made motion that Judge Rodgers be instructed to forward all suits as fast as possible motion seconded and put and carried City Marshall was granted privilege to speak. upon motion Council adjourned to meet at Regular Meeting Aug 9th 1898 at 8 PM
