on second and Grand Sts one on first and white and one on  
third and Quay.

3rd Ward  
1- on 5th and Chepeta Sts - 1- on 6th and Quay 1- 7th and Grand. avz  
1- 8th and Wood avz and 9th and main. ask for Extra light Corner  
white and 8th Streets

4th Ward  
one at Corner main & Eleventh Street = one at Corner  
ute and 8th one at Corner ute & 6th = one at Corner  
South and fourth and one at Stock yard Crossing on  
5th Street

Cost of lights  
upon motion by alderman Currie report of light Committee  
was received and Supt Bentley was instructed to make a  
report at our next meeting as to cost of same.

Pole in
