Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction that we agree to enter into Contract with the Grand Junction Electric Light and Manufacturing Co.

for thirty three (33) candle power incandescent and six arc lights (already located in City) and Electric lights in City Hall on terms at the following rates:

33 incandescents @ \$ 1.50 per light per mo.
6 Arc lights @ \$ 9.00 " " " "

Charges for lights in City Hall to be same as old contract.

incandescent additional lights to be located where indicated by City. Contract to continue from the time lights are in operation to first of May A.D. 1900. City may order additional lights at rates above specified

Total estimate cost of lights \$ 1482.00
