

Grand Junction Colo Dec 13<sup>th</sup> 1898

Regular meeting of City Council upon Roll call the following alderman responded. Currie Weyer. Whorton Star <sup>mayor</sup> McKinney <sup>minutes</sup> of Nov 18<sup>th</sup> read laid over for correction. Street Commissioner Gates made a written report on side walks which had been ordered laid by City Council and owners have not complied with order.

motion was unless the Grand Junction Electric & Mfg Co did not comply with City Council's reasonable request of Nov 10<sup>th</sup> 1898

for reduction in price on Incandescents and arc lights by July 1<sup>st</sup> 1899. if not complied with lights on streets are to be cut out on July 1<sup>st</sup> 1899.

Alderman Whorton offered the following Resolution and same was adopted

# Whorton's Resolution

Whereas, the ordinance providing for purchase of the Grand Junction Water Works by the issuance of \$50000. of bonds. has been repealed by the City Council many months ago. and whereas, there are no negotiations now pending and have been none for many months past between said The Grand Junction Water Company and the City and

whereas, it is earnestly desired by the City Council that all suits now pending between the City and said Company be diligently pursued to a final termination and, whereas, suits in the Court of Appeals have been delayed by representations to said Court that there are still negotiations pending for settlement of all said matters,

Therefore, be it again resolved that any and all negotiations in any way relating to settlement of these matters or any of them be and are hereby declared ceased and entirely at an end and, be it further

Resolved, That the Honorable Court of Appeals be and it hereby is respectfully requested to so consider these matters and not consider any statements to the contrary unless based upon some showing which comes from parties knowing the real condition as it actually exists in these matters and, be it further.

Resolved, that a copy of this resolution be certified to the Clerk of the said Court of Appeals to be used and filed in Case No 1404. and also in Case # 1937. {Thomas vs.
