


Grand Junction Colo. January 14th 1899
adjourn meeting of City Council with Mayor Ela in
Chair upon roll call the following alderman
responded: Alderman McKinney, Whorton, Starr, Hadcock
and Ranney. Absent alderman Currie, Weyer & Dickerson.
Moved by Ald Starr and seconded by Alderman Hadcock
that Guy V. Sternburg act as Clerk Pro Tem. Carried.
Moved by Ald Whorton and seconded by Ald Hadcock
that Thos. S. Peate be permitted to address the Council
in relation to Electric lights, Steam heating &c. Carried.
Alderman Weyer came in after Council was called to
order and participated in proceedings.

By directions of Council the Clerk Pro Tem read the
ordinance proposed by Thos. S. Peate and also Contract.
The Ordinance was introduced by Alderman McKinney.
Moved by Alderman Hadcock and seconded by Ald-
Starr that ordinance be referred to a special committee
of three to be appointed by the Mayor Carried.
Alderman Starr, Weyer & Ranney were appointed as
such committee
