

Grand Jurc So. July 14<sup>th</sup> 1899

Regular meeting of City Council. Mayor Cha in Chair. upon roll call the following Alderman responded. Alderman Dickerson. Wharton. Weyer. McKinney. Ramey. Starr & Hadcock. Absent Alderman Currier. Minutes of Jan'y 10. 13. 14. 19<sup>th</sup> & 24 were read and approved.

The monthly reports of Police. Magistrate. City Janitor. City Marshall and Fire Chief and City Treasurer for month of Jan'y 1899 was read and read by Clerk.
