
Bill SR Voils

Farmers Ditch

upon motion by alderman Whorton the Bill of Rodgers and Shapoth was taken from the table, and upon motion by alderman Starr and seconded by alderman Headcock the bill was referred to the finance Com. Mr Bergen was allowed to address the Council+ Alderman Headcock made motion and seconded by Alderman Starr. That the water takers from what is known as The Farmers Ditch be instructed to cease running water on their present line and that they be permitted to run water from 7th Street west to west side of 4th Street to the north side of Belford Avenue thence west to the west side of 3rd Street thence south on the west side of 3rd Street to the North side of Hill St thence west to the west side of 2nd St thence south on the west side of 2nd St to the North side of Gunnison Ave thence west to the east side of 1st St thence south on the east side of 1st Street to the North side of Chipeta St thence west to the limits of the City and that in granting this privilege the said water consumers be given all rights in their new location that they may now have in the present location of their ditch and no other.

Provided that the Council is not to be understood as recognizing the right of the water consumers of said ditch or any ditch to use the streets of the City for such purpose. The roll was called and was as follows
