There being a tie vote an alderman in third ward it was agreed by the canvassing board to decide the tie by tossing a dollar up same to hit the ceiling and if heads came up M.M. Shores was to be declared alderman of third ward if tails came up F.R. Smith was to be declared alderman of third ward. The dollar was borrowed from alderman Whorton and City Clerk Delaplaine tossed same up and Justice Mann looked at the dollar and said tails was up. The board declared alderman Smith entitled to the seat as alderman of third ward of Grand Junction Colo.
