A communication from W.S. Wallace was read and read pertaining to a Sewerage System for the city of Grand Junction upon motion by alderman Smith and seconded by alderman Shan same was referred to the Water & Light Committee Alderman Whorton introduced the following resolution same was seconded by alderman Dickerson

Geo. A. Currie hereby state to the City Council that I will not bring in any bill for services in connection with the sale of Gregory's Bonds. Geo. A. Currie

Whereas the taxpayers of the City of Grand Junction have authorized the issuance of \$65,000.00 of City Bonds for the purpose of erecting a system of water works by and for the City of Grand Junction; and
Whereas the Supreme Court of Colorado has recently affirmed the validity of these bonds and the right of the City to issue them and to erect such works, and
Whereas George A. Currie has recently received an offer of the par value for said bonds from responsible parties;
Now therefore, Be it Resolved that said George A. Currie be and hereby is authorized to sell and dispose of said bonds within thirty days from this date, said bonds to be sold for cash at the par value thereof and the money received therefor to be used for the purpose of erecting a system of water works for said City.

The City Council will take the necessary steps to legally and properly issue said bonds in accordance with the wishes of the purchasers thereof, and any delay caused thereby in preparing said bonds, shall not be deducted from said thirty days above mentioned.

When so prepared, the Mayor, Treasurer and City Clerk are authorized and directed to sign and deliver the same to said Currie or order, upon payment of the cash therefor to the legal custodian of the City.

Alderman Whorton moved the adoption of above and seconded by Alderman Brownson

Alderman Smith made motion to amend same and seconded by Alderman Levy same be referred to the Water and Light Committee.

Upon motion by Alderman Star all citizens were allowed to address the Council in connection of the \$65,000.00 bonds

Alderman Levy made motion as amendment and seconded by Alderman Smith that the bonds be advertised for sale to the highest and best bidder for a period of 30 days. The amendment was lost.

Upon motion Mr Peal was allowed to address the Council. The Council took a vote on the Whorton Resolution which was as follows. Alderman Smith yay Whorton yay Dickerson yay Hanny yay Star yay Brownson yay Levy yay The motion carried.

Alderman Star introduced Ordinance # Concerning amendment to Section 1 one of Ordinance # 69. passed and adopted Feb 9 1898

Upon motion same was referred to Finance Committee upon motion by Alderman Whorton the election of all officers by the Council was laid over until next meeting upon motion by Alderman Whorton Council adjourned to meet April 24 1899
