Resolution of the City Council of Grand Junction Co. So.

Be it resolved of the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, that the Mayor, City Clerk, and Treasurer are hereby authorized and instructed to sign and deliver the \$80,000 of City Bonds now in possession of the City Clerk over to the possession of the City Treasurer when so properly signed, and be it further resolved that the Mesa Savings Bank is hereby instructed to deliver and turn over to said City Treasurer the \$35,000 Bonds now in its possession, and be it further resolved that the City Treasurer is hereby instructed to clip off Coupons from said bonds up to the date of May 1" 1899, and to cancel same. Be it further resolved that the City Treasurer is hereby instructed to make draft for \$65,000, and attach it to the City Bonds, after so doing, to express the bonds with draft attached to the Cashier of the First National Bank of Colorado Springs with instructions to turn them over an order of George A. Currie, upon receipt of \$65,000, which money is to be placed to the credit of the City Treasurer of Grand Junction, or forwards to his order.
