Curry Motion
to Supt. Smith

Alderman Curry made as a substitute the following
motion: Resolved that the petition of M.M. Shores, subverting
the right of F.R. Smith to sit as Councilman of the Third
Ward be dismissed, because it is not supported by the
evidence and the law; and that F.R. Smith be and is hereby
declared entitled to the said office

The roll was called on the Whorton motion and was as
follows. Raney Nay. Curry Nay. Starr Nay. McKimney Nay.

The Mayor declared the Curry motion carried and the
Whorton motion lost and that F.R. Smith was entitled
to the seat as Alderman of the third ward.

Alderman Bronner left the Council room just after the
vote on the Whorton motion +

Alderman McKimney made motion and seconded by
Alderman Starr that the Council reconsider the vote
on the Curry motion seating F.R. Smith
