

Grand Junction Colo. June 3rd 1899

Adjourn meeting of City Council Mayor Cha in chair upon roll call the following aldermen suspended, Whorton, Dickerson, Star, McKinney, Covy and Smith about Bronner and Rauvey.

Whereas Alderman Smith introduced the following Resolution It is the intention of this Council to proceed to construction of a correct and adequate system of water works; and

Whereas: there is a set of plans and specifications now in existence but not present; and

Whereas: we the members of this Council feel incompetent to judge as to the merits and demerits of such plans and specifications; and

Whereas. It is our intention to advertise for bids for the construction of a plant in accordance with the plans to be adopted; now therefore

Resolved: That we engage the services of a competent and impartial hydraulic engineer to consult and advise with us to plans and specifications that may be submitted; also to advise as to a sewer system; and to draw plans if so instructed; and also to advise on all questions as to water and sewers, as he may be called upon to do by this Council
