

Grand Junction June 9th 1899

Adjourn meeting of City Council Mayor Eda in chain upon roll call the following Alderman responded Alderman Dickerson, Leary, Ranney, McKinney, Sam Brownson, Smith and Whorton

Minutes of May 9, 15, 18, 22, 25, 26, 27 and 29. June 2 and 3 were read and approved with corrections. A Petition signed by S R Voils and others was read and read asking Council to take some action in having side-walk in front of Lots 29, 30 & 31 in Block 29 repaired and made safe.

Petition of S R Voils

upon motion by Alderman Starr Street Com Gates addressed the Council upon the side walk in question Alderman McKinney City Clerk was instructed to notify owner of Lots 29, 30 & 31 in Block 29, to repair same at once.

Frank Bathina License to W S Hammond.

upon motion by Alderman Smith and seconded by Alderman Dickerson the Job^{ys} Express license of Frank Bathina was transferred to W S Hammond for the unexpired term

Richard Gill Petition

A Petition was read and read from Richard Gill asking Council to grant him a Job^{ys} Express license to date from June 1st 1899 to Apr 1st 1900 for \$12.00 or from June 1st 1899 to June 1st 1900 for \$18.00

upon motion by Alderman Ranney and seconded by Alderman Dickerson the request was refused +

Bond of M R McKinney as Night Marshall

The Bond of M R McKinney as Night Marshall for \$500.00 was read and read showing as signers M R McKinney Geo Gates and A S McKinney upon motion by Alderman Smith and seconded by Alderman Leary the Bond was accepted +

B F Jay Lots 14 inches into in Alley

Alderman Starr Chairman of the Street & Alley Committee made a verbal report on petition of B F Jay in regard to fence being 14 inches in Alley, on West end of Lots 17 & 18 in Block # 83

upon motion by Alderman Brownson and seconded by Alderman Smith owners are to be notified to put fence on true lot line.

Beds & cts for Fire Co.

Alderman Smith made motion and seconded by Alderman Whorton that City buy 3 Double Beds 3 Mattress and 3 Springs also 4 Pair of Rubber Boots 4 Rubber Coats for the use of the Fire Company same was allowed and passed by the following vote Dickerson yea, Leary yea, Ranney yea, McKinney yea, Starr yea, Brownson yea, Smith yea, Whorton yea.

Beds in City Jail.

upon motion by Alderman Dickerson and seconded by Alderman Brownson the repairing of Beds in the City Jail were referred to the Police Committee with power to act +

upon motion by Alderman Whorton and seconded by Alderman Dickerson the Street & Alley Committee were

Instructed to rent 25 inches of water for use of city upon motion by alderman Starr and seconded by alderman McKinney the repairing of Rail Road crossing an main Street crossing the Little Rock Cliff Rail road was referred to city Atty barnahan for a decision as to who should repair same +

Now new Bills were read and upon motion by alderman Promsor same was referred to the Finance Committee upon motion by alderman Starr. D. R. Crosby was allowed to address the Council upon Sewerage + upon motion Mayor Ecla. appointed Alderman Barry to fill vacancy on City Sewerage Committee + Alderman McKinney moved the adoption of the following Resolution and seconded by alderman Promsor.

it appears from the files of the city clerk's Office that a Contract was purported to be entered into between the city and Frank H. Strong and Charles B. Allen of Denver on May 28th 1896 for the construction of a so called mountain water system of water works - and

said Contract provides that in case the sale of said Bonds is not effected by September 1st A.D. 1896 and the Contractors shall not on or before that date elect to take the same in payment of such construction in payment hereof Cash. then this Contract may be cancelled at the option of either party thereto by giving to the other written notice of their intention to cancel the same and

said Bonds were not sold nor accepted and the time stated in said contract is long past. Therefore be it Resolved that the said contract be and the same is hereby cancelled - and be it further

Resolved that notice of this cancellation be given to said Strong and Allen by the city clerk of the city mailing by Registered letter a copy of this Resolution to them at Denver Colorado.

Mayor Ecla put the motion on the adoption of same carried + a Communication from Cripple Creek inviting the Firemen to attend the Fourth of July Celebration at Cripple Creek was read. Fire Chief Garban was allowed to address the Council + He ask the Council to donate \$300.00 to defray the Expense of sending a running team to Cripple Creek. upon motion by alderman McKinney the request was referred to the Fire Committee + upon motion by alderman Dickerson and seconded by alderman Wharton Council adjourned to meet Saturday June 10th at 2 P.M.
