original section # 14 of the city and mains & outlets
the same to be in all respect up to the standards of
service in modern sanitary sewerage and said survey
plans and specification not to cost more than \$750.00
and to include maps blue prints plans drawings
and specification complete in all details and to be
approved by the City Council

Alderman McKinney introduced the following Resolution
That a committee consisting of Alderman Smith Cory
McKinney and Brunsen be and hereby are appointed to be
known as the Special Water Committee should any
vacancy or vacancies occur in this Committee. Such
vacancy or vacancies shall be filled by a vote of Council

at any regular meeting.

It shall be the duty of said Water Committee to immediately secure the services of a competent engineer for the purpose of consultation in all matters pertaining to the construction of water works for the city of Grand Junction, and also to investigate for a system of mountain water works, taken as a source of supply such streams or springs as may be available. In the selection of an engineer this committee shall be restricted only to some one who is in no way interested in any material that may be used, or in the contract for construction, of any water works that may be constructed by the city of Grand Junction.

Said Special Water Committee shall report to this council the name of the engineer they employ, the time for which or terms under which he is employed, and the amount of compensation he shall receive. Therefore,

Alderman Bronner came in and took part in the meeting. Alderman ~~Wharton~~ made McKinney move the adoption of same seconded by Alderman Covey upon motion by Alderman Wharton to amend the resolution the name of Alderman Dickerson was added to the Spl Water Committee by the following vote.
