The monthly report of Police Magistrate and City Treasurer for month of Apr 1899 was approved by Finance Committee and upon motion by Alderman Whorton same was accepted and placed on file

Alderman Starr Chairman of the Street and Alley Committee Recommended Side Walks as follows: along Quay Street in front of Lots 25 to 32 in Block # 60 also in front of Lots 17 to 22 inclusive on Quay Street and along the East side of Lot 17 on Sixth St Block 51.

Alderman Starr made the following written report on Sewerage Contract +

This agreement made and entered into this 13th day of June AD 1899, by and between the City of Grand Junction, Municipal Corporation of the County of Mesa, State of Colorado, party of the first part, and E. W. Hathaway of Pueblo Colo. party of the second part. Witnesseth;

That for and in consideration of the payment hereinafter agreed to be made, the said party of the second part agrees.

to make for the party of the first part, a complete and accurate survey of the original city of Grand Junction as now platted and recorded, namely: the entire section Fourteen, Twp. one, South Rg one West 12th Meridian, with complete and accurate plans, profiles, specifications, in detail for a Sewer System in this city, the same to include a survey and plans for such mains and outlets as shall be found necessary for a good and complete Sewer System;

And it is further agreed by the parties hereto, that the said plans shall include a large map on mounted paper showing all Blocks, lots, streets, alleys, main and lateral sewers, locations of man holes, flush tanks etc. And, it is further agreed that said plans shall include in detail all detail matters of and for each and all of said matters, and that said plans and profiles shall contain all necessary information for the construction at this time, or at any future time any or all sewers to be embraced within the aforesaid territory including the both lengths of lines for main and lateral sewers the amounts of excavation necessary for the laying of each and all said lines, the various sizes of pipes suitable for the construction thereof, the proper and most suitable material with directions as to laying the same, and with estimates of the cost for pipe delivered at Grand Junction

and also with estimates of the cost of excavating and filling and performing all such work as shall be necessary for the proper construction of a completed System of Sewerage for said city;

And, it is further agreed that the said plans, profiles, specifications, estimates, maps, drawings and recommendations shall be completed and or before first day of August AD 1899, and filed with the city clerk of the city of Grand Junction for the inspection and acceptance of the City Council.

And, it is hereby agreed that the city shall pay to the said party of the second part upon the completion and acceptance of said work the sum of Seven hundred and Fifty (\$750.00) in legal tenders of the city; and it is further agreed that should the services of the said second party be found necessary or advisable in the construction of the work, the said party of the second part should render services in advising and directing the work for a sum not to exceed Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) per day, with the necessary traveling expenses from the city of Pueblo to Grand Junction for such times or times as the said party of the first part shall deem necessary for the good of the work.

In witness whereof, said Contract has been executed in duplicate by the order of the City Council by the Mayor and City Clerk on the part of the city and by the party of the second part hereto the day and year above first written
