Be it Resolved: That Whereas, C.P. Allen, Consulting Engineer, has proposed to  
this City that he will furnish full and complete plans and  
specifications for the water works system to be constructed  
by the City as at present contemplated, and that he will also  
deliver to the City the plans and specifications heretofore prepared  
by him for a main water system of water works for this  
City, and he will superintend in his capacity as engineer  
the construction of the present contemplated system of water  
works for for this City; all for the sum of \$2,500.00 and  
his necessary expenses incurred for Rail Road Fare & Hotel Bills  
while engaged in superintending said works

Now Therefore


Be it Resolved: That the City hereby accepts the said offer of  
the said C.P. Allen, and accepts the said plans & specifications  
so prepared by him, and which are to be completed as to all  
details by a date not later than June 22<sup>nd</sup> 1899, and that  
the City Clerk be and he is hereby instructed to advertise  
for bids for the construction of said water works plant and  
System in such manner and in such news papers as  
is usual and customary in such cases; said bids to be  
received until and opened on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of July AD 1899  
the right being reserved on the part of the City to reject  
any and all bids

Alderman Rainey moved the adoption of same seconded  
by alderman Whorton  
Alderman McKimney made a Substitute motion that  
same be laid on table until this Council reads full  
plans and specifications of water works System from  
Mr C.P. Allen also until City Clerk and City Atty make  
their report on the records as to Contract between City  
and Mr C.P. Allen

upon motion by alderman Rainey all Citizens were  
granted the privilege to address the Council  
The roll was called upon Alderman McKimney motion  
and was as follows Carry ya. Smith ya. Starr ya  
McKimney ya. Dickerson ya. Whorton ya. Rainey ya  
Prosser ya. Carried

alderman Whorton made a favorable report on the  
application of Walter Wilhelm for a Beer Store  
license and recommended that license be granted  
Alderman Dickerson made motion and seconded by  
alderman Prosser that report be accepted also Bond  
of Walter Wilhelm and a Beer Store license granted  
said Walter Wilhelm for 6 months the roll was  
called and was as follows Carry ya. Smith ya

 upon motion by alderman Dickerson and seconded by
