

Grand Junction Colo. June 30 1899

at town meeting of City Council Mayor Cole in Chair upon roll call the following alderman responded. Covy Dickerson McKinney Ramey Starr Smith & Whorton absent Alderman Bronner.

upon motion by alderman Starr the reading of previous meetings minutes were laid over.

Crosby be and hereby is employed as supervising Engineer for the City of Grand Junction for the construction of said

water works until such time as he shall be discharged by this Council and that his compensation shall be fixed at the rate of \$ 15.00 per day for all ~~work~~ time actually employed by him in the service of the city and that he shall be during the time of his employment by the city subject at all times to the orders <sup>and</sup> direction of the Special Water Committee
