

Grand Jury Colo July 11 1899

Regular meeting of City Council Mayor Ela in Chair upon roll call the following alderman responded Brounser Cary Dickerson McKinney Ranney Smith & Whorton absent Alderman Starr

Minutes of June 26 and 30 read & approved with corrections A petition was read and read asking Council ~~to~~ to build new side walk as follows. To wit commencing on west side of Spruce St 75 feet south of White running thence south to Colorado Ave along blocks 4 and 5 and 8 in Mabley addition also on East side of Spruce from Road to Colorado Avenue along block 6 and 7 in Mabley's add. Same was signed by J. H. Herron and 8 others.

Petition in Mabley's add. for side walk.

Petition for side walk in Block 51.

A petition was read and read asking Council to build new side walk as follows. To wit on north side of Block 51 and on south side of Gunnison Avenue between 5 and 6 Streets same was signed by E. N. Gayton Agent and 4 others.

Petition for side walk in Block 102 & 97

A petition was read and read asking Council to build a new side walk as follows To wit be laid on the west side of fourth Street from the alley in Block 102 to Road Ave. and also from Road Avenue to White Street on said fourth Street along the East side of Block 97 Same was signed by Mrs. S. Season and 3 others.

upon motion by alderman McKinney and seconded by alderman Dickerson the Prayers of Petitioners for new side walk were granted and side walk ordered laid and same to be 6 feet wide The roll was called up on the 3 above side walk Petitions and <sup>the vote</sup> was as follows Brounser yeas. Cary yeas. Dickerson yeas. McKinney yeas. Ranney yeas. Smith yeas. and Whorton yeas.

upon motion by Alderman Whorton and seconded by alderman Dickerson Street Commissioner was instructed to have side walks laid at once.

Side walk in Block 73 & 82.

upon motion by Alderman Smith and seconded by alderman McKinney Lot owners of the following lots were ordered to build new side walk 6 feet wide To wit: East side of Lots 16 and 12 in Block 82 and East side Lots 16 and 17. Block 73. The roll was called and vote was as follows. Brounser yeas. Cary yeas. Dickerson yeas. McKinney yeas. Ranney yeas. Smith yeas. and Whorton yeas. Mr. P. Alby was allowed to address Council.

also pool for Chipman Block.

A petition was read and read from Ranney Bros Agent of Richard Chipman asking Council to grant them the privilege of digging a cist pool on Lot 26 in Bk 118 across alley from Chipman Block. for use of said Chipman Block.

upon motion by alderman Whorton and seconded by alderman Dickerson the petition of Ranney Bros was granted also permission was given Mr. Toland to dig new cist pool

Herman F. Ziemann. License was ask for from  
July 11<sup>th</sup> 1899 to January 11<sup>th</sup> 1900.

Alderman Whorton that petition be granted also Bond  
of the Milwaukee Brewery be accepted and license be  
granted The Milwaukee Brewery as to application from  
July 11<sup>th</sup> 1899 to July 11<sup>th</sup> 1900. The roll was called and the

The Mayor declared license granted for 6 months +

upon motion by Alderman Dickerson The Gentry Show are allowed to give 2 performances in one day with Dogs, Bonnets & etc for a license fee of \$10.<sup>00</sup>

upon motion by Alderman Brown Council adjourned to meet Friday evening July 21<sup>st</sup> 1899 at 8 O'Clock
