the City Clerk, be and the same are hereby accepted and
prescribed for its construction in detail as to all matters
pertaining to said Sanitary Sewers for and within
the limits of Sewer District No 1, including all laterals
mains, flush-tanks, man-holes and appurtenances
necessary for the construction of said system, including
connecting mains and outlets and such portions
thereof as may be necessary to connect with the

with interest on all deferred payments at the rate of
6% per annum payable semi-annually until paid,
and payable on April 1st each year until paid and

Be it Further Resolved, that the entire cost of construction (with
interest thereon) of said Sewers, for said District No 1
according to said plans and specifications, including
the construction of the connecting main from a point
on 1st St. at its intersection with the alley in Block 100
to a point designated on Sewer map as Station 20 + 36
(being the eastern end of the main public Sewer)

Be assessed against all the real estate in said district in proportion as the area of each piece of real estate therein is to the area of all real estate in the district exclusive of public highways. and Resolved that the City Engineer be, and is hereby requested to prepare and file in the office of City Clerk and estimate of the cost of the same, with a map of the District No 1, and a schedule showing the approximate amounts to be assessed on the several lots, or parcels of property within said District, provided said engineer shall use such matters as may be appropriate in the data and specifications prepared.

Be it further Resolved, That the City Engineer be, and is hereby requested to prepare and file in the Office of the City Clerk, an estimate of the cost of the same with a map of said District No 2, and a schedule showing the approximate amounts to be assessed on the several lots, or parcels of property within said District, provided said Engineer shall use such matters as may be appropriate to the data plans and specifications prepared and submitted by said C. W. Hathaway.


