 City Council on considering objections and
 complaints that may be made thereto. and that the
 time for opening said bids be set for Sept 22
 A.D. 1899. at 8 o'clock P.M. and be it further
 Resolved that the City Attorney and Clerk prepare
 forms for proposals and that no bids be received
 except they be upon such forms: and that a
 deposit of 3% of the total amount of each bid
 accompany the same to be forfeited to the City if the
 party awarded the contract fails to sign up the
 contract and bonds within 10 days after contract is
 awarded and that the Council reserves the right
 to reject any or all bids.

 bids for sewer contracts.


