


Grand Junction Sept 1st 1899

ad from meeting of City Council Mayor Elm in Chair upon roll call the following alderman responded. Alderman Lavy, McKinney, Starr, Smith and Ramsey. Alderman Starr introduced the following Resolutions

Be it Resolved By the City Council of the City of Grand Junction that an Election be and is hereby called to be held at the City Hall in the City of Grand Junction Monday Sept 11th 1899 between the hours of 9 am and 7 P. M. of said day at which election shall be submitted to the qualified voters in said city who have paid taxes during the preceding year upon property in said city the question of the settlement of all matters between the Grand Junction Water Co and the City of Grand Junctions buying its water works and system at a total cost for a settlement to purchase of not to exceed \$50000⁰⁰ Dollars to also to construct a Mountain Water system in accordance with the Phelps Plans to the total cost of all aforesaid not to exceed \$116000⁰⁰ Dollars and issue Bonds therefor to be it further resolved that the City Clerk shall provide ballots for use of the voters at said Election upon which shall be printed the words - For settlement of Water Question and Mountain Water - Against settlement of Water Question and Mountain Water. with a suitable squares opposite each in which the voter shall place a cross in said squares. and be it further resolved that the City Clerk publish a notice of this Election in one daily paper in the City and also in the official paper of the City as soon as possible to until said election day. which notice shall include a copy of this resolution and that said City Clerk procure from the proper officers for use at said Election - Certified list of voters and tax payers for use of Election Judges. Alderman ^{Starr} moved the adoption and seconded by Alderman McKinney the vote was called and the vote was as follows Lavy yeas McKinney yeas Starr yeas Smith yeas and Ramsey Nays. Passed upon motion by Alderman Smith Council adjourned to Sept 1st 1899 at 8 P M.
