

Graud Junction held Sept 8th 1899

Adm'n meeting of City Council Mayor E. in Chair upon roll call the following alderman responded Alderman Dickerson, Smith, Star, McKinney, & Curry About Alderman Thomas, Ranney, & Wharton a letter was read by City Clerk from Marshall Mann giving as reason for not attending Council meetings was sickness

whereas

Alderman McKinney introduced the following Resolution A proposition has been received from the Graud Junction Water Company, to sell its plant and all its property in the City for the sum of Forty nine Thousand Six Hundred Dollars (\$49,600⁰⁰), and without further consideration, to release all ~~its~~ claims against the City, including hydraulic rentals, and to dismiss all law suits now pending at its own expense, with the exception of one suit in which the costs are to be divided; and further, proposes to turn the possession of said plant and property over to City and receive the purchase price, when the title to the same shall be found to be free and clear from all incumbrances;

Resolved,

That the proposition, to purchase said plant and property for the sum of Forty-nine Thousand, Six Hundred Dollars (\$49,600⁰⁰) under the above conditions, be submitted to the qualified electors, who are Tax-payers under the Law, to be voted upon at a special election to be held in said City on the 16th day of September A.D. 1899, from Seven O'clock in the forenoon until Seven O'clock in the afternoon of said day; that said election be held at the City Hall corner Colorado Ave. and 5th Street That L. P. Cary, W. J. Brennan, and W. A. Abby be and are hereby appointed as judges of said election That the City Clerk be instructed to procure from the County Treasurer a certified copy of the Tax-payers, entitled to vote, and that the same be furnished to said judges. All persons voting to purchase said water works and property shall have written or printed on their ballot the words "For the Purchase of the Water works"; and all persons voting against the purchase of said water works and property shall have written or printed upon their ballots the words "Against The Purchase of the Water works"

Resolved

that the question be submitted to qualified tax-payers on Monday Sept 18th from 7 am to 7 pm Same judges and place as above.
