

Graud Junction Colo Sept 18th 1899

adjuorn meeting of City Council Mayor Ecla in chair upon roll call the following alderman responded. Alderman Brunner Leary Dickerson McKinney Star Smith Ranney ^{and} Whorton all present.

upon motion by Alderman Dickerson the regular order of Business was Dispensed with and the Spl water question was taken up.

alderman Whorton made the following written motion and seconded by Alderman Dickerson

I move that a contract for water works for the City of Graud Junction be awarded to Seddis ^{and} Serris Stone Co. as per their bid now on file subject to such changes in character and size of pipe, as the Council in connection with the Engineer may make. Commencing at the Summison River and progressing towards the opposite extremities and completing the system as far as the money now or that may be available will permit upon motion by alderman Whorton all Citizens were allowed to address the Council.

The roll was called upon the Whorton motion to let award the Contract and the vote was as follows. Brunner yea. Leary yea. Dickerson yea. McKinney yea. Star yea. Smith yea. Ranney yea. ^{and} Whorton yea. Carried upon motion by Alderman Star City Clerk was instructed to notify Seddis ^{and} Serris Stone Co that they had been awarded the Contract.

upon motion by Alderman Star The Mayor ^{and} City Clerk were instructed to sign Contract for new water works where same was drawn up in proper shape and order by the following vote. Brunner yea. Leary yea. Dickerson yea. McKinney yea. Star yea. Smith yea. Ranney yea. ^{and} Whorton yea.

Alderman Star introduced the following written Resolution that all objections to construction of Sewers that may now be filed be finally considered tomorrow evening Sept 19-1899 and that when Council adjourn it adjourn until Sept 19-99 at 8 o'clock P.M. The roll was called and the vote was as follows. Leary yea. Dickerson yea. McKinney yea. Star yea. Smith yea. Ranney yea. ^{and} Whorton yea. Alderman Brunner had left Council room.

Alderman Star made a favorable report on Petition of J.B. Barnard to fence Block 41 - same to be fenced with smooth wire Alderman Star made motion and seconded by Alderman McKinney that the Petition of J.B. Barnard be granted and same to be fenced with smooth wire same carried. Alderman Star made verbal report on work of Draining pond in nobleys addition stating same had been done in a very satisfactory matter and recommended the payment due Harry Goldsmith be made and upon motion by Alderman Dickerson and seconded by Ald Whorton
