ad journ meeting of City Council mayor Eley in chair upon roll call the following alderman responded Corby Dickerson McKinney Smith Starr Ramsey and Whorton absent alderman Brommer upon motion by alderman Whorton the regular order of Business was dispensed with and the special order of Water Business was taken up upon motion by Alderman Ramsey Geo. W. Stennitz addressed the Council upon the water question Alderman Brommer came in and took part in the Council meeting

City Atty Barnahan read a Resolution on a special Election to vote for \$20000 Dollars more bonds after considerable discussion on same a motion was made by alderman Whorton and seconded by Alderman Dickerson that portion of the Resolution pertaining to rate of interest on the Bonds was referred to the Finance Committee to make a report on interest rate inside of 10 days. Carried Alderman Whorton made motion and seconded by Alderman Dickerson that City Atty Barnahan draw up a contract between the City of Grand Junction and Geddis and Series Stone Co for new water works so as to be ready to sign tomorrow night and when we adjourn we adjourn to meet at 8 PM on Sept 21 1899 The roll was called and the vote was as follows. A letter was read and read from Thos. Fisher in regard to the Colver land on and near the Garrison River upon motion by alderman Dickerson same was referred to the City Atty and City Engineer

upon motion by Alderman Dickerson the Purchasing Committee were given the power to purchase spittoons for the Council room.

upon motion by Alderman Dickerson Council adjourned to meet at 8 PM Sept 21 1899
