A petition was read and read from G. J. Lewis atty for The Graud Junction Water Co with drawing his proposition to reduce the purchase price of its water works plant property and privilege from \$55,000.00 to \$49,600.00 and to sell the same at the least named sum. No action taken

Two Summons were read from the Graud Junction Water Company one to enforce the contract between the city and the Graud Junction Water Co to purchase water plant at \$55,000.00 which contract was made between June 1st & May 1st 1898. and the other restraining the city building water works

upon motion by alderman Star same was referred to the city atty. The Bill of M. Delaplain #223. for \$12.20 which had been approved by the finance committee was allowed & clerk instructed to draw warrant for same by the following vote Brumer yea. Cury yea. Dickerson yea. McKinnay yea. Smith yea. Star yea. Ramey yea. Whorton yea.

17. New Bills were read and read by city clerk and upon motion by alderman Star and seconded by alderman Dickerson same was referred to the finance committee

upon motion by alderman Ramey and seconded by alderman Whorton the clerk was instructed to make the records show the result of Spl Election held Sept 16" on Purchase or against Purchase of the old water works and on Sept 18" to build to Linnison River or not. To build to maintain or not.

upon motion by alderman Ramey city clerk was given power to purchase a Book to record the results of all elections in. By the following vote Brumer yea. Cury yea. Dickerson yea. McKinnay yea. Smith yea. Star yea. Ramey yea. Whorton yea.

alderman Whorton made motion and seconded by alderman Dickerson That Original Contract and Bond be furnished Geo. W. Sternitz representative of Sedds & Sevie Stone Co to be signed by them for the New Water works same carried

alderman Dickerson made motion and seconded by alderman Smith the buying of dirt of J. Brumden at the rate of 10 cents per load be referred to the Street & Alley Committee with power to act.

upon motion by alderman Star Council adjourned to meet Sept 22nd at 8 P M
