ad from meeting of city council mayor Eola in chair upon roll call the following alderman responded
Bromser, Cory, Starr, Smith, Ramey, Whorton
absent alderman Dickerson and McKinney
upon motion by alderman Bromser the regular order of business was dispensed with and ordinance # 86 was taken up:

Alderman Bromser made motion and seconded by alderman Smith Ordinance # 86 ^{for construction} ~~ordinance~~ ^{in contract} ~~ordinance~~ ^{and} placed upon its passage and adoption
The roll was called and the vote was as follows

upon motion by alderman Starr and seconded by alderman Smith Street Com was instructed to shut off sprinkling street on Oct 1 1899
By the following vote Bromser ye, Cory ye, Starr ye, Smith ye, Ramey ye, Whorton ye.

A letter was read from L.F. Caswell Atty for the Grand Junction Water Co with draughting their bill of \$550. for water furnished for street sprinkling
upon motion by alderman Ramey Council took a recess to talk over the annual levy.

upon motion by alderman Ramey and seconded by alderman Starr the following Resolution was adopted by the following vote
Cory, Starr, Smith, Ramey and Whorton voting ye
alderman Bromser had left council room

Annual Levy of Taxes

Resolution Annual Levy -
Resolved by the city council of the city of Grand Junction Colo that for defraying the expense and liabilities of the city of Grand Junction for the fiscal year beginning April 1 1900 and ending March 31 1901 there be and hereby is levied and assessed upon all the taxable property within the limits of the city both real and personal the following amount to wit: Twenty mills (20) on each dollar of taxable property as the same is assessed and by it further Resolved that the city clerk be and is hereby instructed to certify this levy
