we recommend to this Council that David R. Crosby
and Herman Phillips be employed to look after
the interest of the City during the time of the construction
of water works and also the construction of a system
of sewers they to furnish all tools and instruments
for use for the purpose. also to furnish such extra
men as in their judgement are needed for the
proper inspection of all material and works and
also they shall make all survey and set all stakes
for lines and grades and also do all other work that
naturally comes within the scope of their business.
we also recommend that the Council pay to the
above named Engineers a sum equal to 2 1/2 per
cent on water fund and 6 per cent on fund
expended for sewers.
