 Alderman Whorton made written Resolution as

Whereas. Reuben E. Starr, Alderman from the fourth ward <sup>and</sup>  
 A. S. McHenry, Alderman from the second wards  
 of the City of Grand Junction, were on the 16th day  
 of October 1899 duly convicted in the District Court  
 of the Seventh Judicial District sitting in and for Mesa  
 County Colorado, of Solicitation of Bribery and were duly  
 sentenced by said Court to imprisonment for said offences  
 and  
 Whereas. under Article 12 Section 4 of the Constitution of  
 the State of Colorado, said facts create a vacancy in the  
 office of Alderman for the fourth ward and second  
 ward of said City, now therefore be it  
 Resolved that this Council proceed to fill said vacancies.  
 Alderman Whorton moved the adoption and seconded  
 by Alderman Dickerson. The roll was called and  
 the vote was as follows. Prommer yea. Dickerson yea  
 Ranney yea. Whorton yea. Chairman Ranney declared  
 same passed and adopted.  
 upon motion to. P. McHenry name was placed in  
 nomination as Alderman of second ward in  
 place of A. S. McHenry deceased term +  
 The roll was called and the vote was as follows  
 Prommer yea. Dickerson yea. Ranney yea and  
 Whorton yea. Chairman Ranney declared.  
 P. McHenry Elected Alderman of the second ward  
 upon motion by Alderman Whorton City Marshall  
 escorted C. P. McHenry to the Council room.

The following written report was received from  
 J. W. Smith acting City Marshall. Oct 25 1899  
 To the Mayor & City Council etc. upon request of your  
 body at a meeting held on the evening of the 24th inst  
 to bring Alderman C. Cury before your Honorable  
 body. Will say that I found him and demanded  
 of him to proceed to the Council room, who refused  
 to go. Signed J. W. Smith acting Marshall.  
 upon motion by Alderman Dickerson the report  
 of J. W. Smith was read and adopted.  
 upon motion by Alderman Dickerson and  
 seconded by Alderman Whorton the following  
 written motion was adopted.

bribery and that L. P. McLeary has duly qualified
