

Grand Junction Mo Oct 26 1899.

Adjourned Meeting of City Council upon roll call the following
Alderman responded Promiser. Dickerson. Ranney
Whorton. Albus. Alderman Cory. McKinney. Smith
and Starr also. Mayor Eben Ald Ranney in Chair
Alderman Whorton made motion and seconded by
Alderman Dickerson that city clerk place the name of
L.P. McBarry on the roll as Alderman of the second
ward and call same Carried

The City Clerk refused to call same as City Atty
Larnahan had given him Instruct to call old
list of Aldermen and not the name of L.P. McBarry
as he had not been legally elected as Alderman
of the second ward.

Alderman Whorton made motion and seconded by
Dickerson that L.P. McBarry take his seat as Alderman
of the second ward and Clerk Call the roll. Carried
The Clerk called the list as follows. Promiser
Cory. Dickerson. McKinney. Starr. Smith. Ranney
and Whorton.

upon motion by Alderman Whorton the regular
order of business was dispured with and new
business taken up.

upon motion by Alderman Whorton and seconded

To Honorable Mayor and City Council of Grand Junction Colorado
Sirs Relative to the Granting of Saloon Licenses now
before your body - I desire to state that you have no
legal right to do so at this time and with the members
of the Council present for the reasons -

First That you do not have a quorum present for the
transaction of business

Second. The Licenses cannot be granted beyond the
municipal year in which it is granted

Third. The applications are not before this Council being in
the hands of the License Committee
