Special meeting of City Council. Mayor Edwin
Chair. The roll was called and the following alderman
responded Bromley Conroy. D. Dickerson McKinney
Smith. Starr. Ramsey and Whorton
upon motion by Alderman Ramsey. L. A. Staley
was allowed to address the Council.
upon motion by Alderman Conroy the Council
proceeded to do business under the call.
After considerable discussion as to whom had
a right to vote. Mayor Edwin made a ruling that
members of Council whom had been elected by
the people.

Alderman Whorton appealed from decision of
the Chair and entered protest as to the right of
Alderman McKinney and Starr having right to vote.
Alderman Smith introduced the following Resolution
Be it Resolved by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction
that the City Treasurer be and hereby is instructed to
transfer all interest earned by the \$65000.00 in his
hands from the sale of Water Bonds to the credit of the
"special fund interest on water bonds".

which said special fund is hereby created - ^{and}
Be it further resolved that said City Treasurer collect and
receive all money now due the City in the hands of
the County Treasurer of Mesa County and place so
much of the same as may be necessary to pay the
Semi-annual interest now due on water bonds
to the credit of said "Interest on Water Bonds" fund ^{and}

Be it further resolved that said treasurer pay any and
all coupons on water bonds hereto for properly
issued. out of said fund as the same are presented
for payment and cancel the same and report to this
Council accordingly - - - - -
