notice to Mayor Ala stating reasons why they
would not sit and serve as Alderman with
R.F. Star and A.S. McKimney. Alderman Ranney read
his. after reading same Whorton and Ranney left the
Council room without being excused.

to address the Council


upon motion by Alderman Smith Clerk was instructed
