Barnard read a contract signed by Seddis Seers Stone Co. pertaining to readvertising by Seers for Dist No 1 and 2. Alderman Smith introduced preliminary order

Sanitary Sewer District Number one of the City of Grand Junction Colorado.  
upon motion by Alderman Smith and recorded by Alderman McKinney the following Contract was ordered spread upon the records.

To The Honorable Mayor and City Council & the City Clerk of the City of Grand Junction Colorado.  
Sirs:- The Seddis and Beeris Stone Company hereby consents and agrees that the action of the City Council in awarding the contract for the construction of Sanitary Sewers in Sewer Districts Nos. one and two may be revoked and re-considered, and that in doing so the bid which the Seddis and Beeris Stone Company has heretofore made shall upon the amended proceedings stand as their bid for the construction of said sanitary sewers in each of said sewer districts, respectively, according to the plans and specifications heretofore adopted, with the right, however, reserved to the said Seddis and Beeris Stone Company to make a bid for each or either of said districts sewers for a less amount than the bid which they have heretofore made thereon; and as an evidence of good faith on their part, and as a forfeiture in case they fail or refuse to enter into contract with the City for the construction of said sewers in each or either of said districts, in case the contract therefor shall be awarded to them when proposals are again received, the City Clerk is hereby instructed to hold for the use of said City, in case their default the certified check now in his hands, heretofore deposited as a forfeiture, in the sum of \$ 2500.

Resolved, that the action of the City Council in awarding contracts in pursuance of the bids so received should be and the same is hereby reconsidered and annulled.


