and Reading Room of the City of Grand Junction, the
sum of \$5000.00 the said City will annuallly thereafter
appropriate and contribute to the support of the same
the sum of \$1200.00 each year, and will also furnish
a suitable site or building location for the same
free of incumbrance, and will do all in its power
to make the same a success in all respects.
