

Grand Junction Colo March 13 1900

Regular meeting of City Council. Mayor Ela in Chair. upon motion J. Barnahan was elected clerk for term upon roll call the following Aldermen responded. Corry. Bronnser. Ramey. Starr. Dickerson. Whorton. McKinney and Smith. Minutes of March 2nd and 3rd read and approved. The monthly reports of City Marshall, City Treasurer and Janitor for Febry 1900 was received and upon motion was refered to Finance Committee. The Finance Committee made report upon officers reports for jany 1900 and upon motion by alderman labory the reports was accepted and placed on file. The Finance Committee made report on the Sect Printing request for funds for write up of Grand Junction Valley. No action was taken.

The purchase Committee made reported that they had purchased Oil for water works plants. upon motion John D. Beeden was allowed to address the council.

upon motion by alderman Corry and seconded by alderman Starr Dept of water works was instructed to fix up Rail Road Crossing ^{to pump house} by the following vote Corry. yea. Bronnser yea. Ramey yea. Starr yea.

Dickerson yea. Whorton yea. McKinney yea. Smith yea upon motion by alderman Whorton the City Clerk was instructed to advertise for 1 year supply of Coal for City water works by the following vote Corry yea. Bronnser yea. Ramey yea. Starr yea.

Dickerson yea. Whorton yea. McKinney yea. Smith yea. The Mayor made report in writing of securing bids and awarding Contract on Sewer District No. 1.

Alderman Whorton moved the adoption of the following Resolution: whereas the Mayor of this City has advertised for bids for the construction of sanitary sewers in Sewer District No. 1 of the City of Grand Junction as per Ordinance No 90 and has publicly received and accepted the same and has found that the bid of The Geddiss and Beris Stone Co. for the sum \$12134.00 is the lowest responsible bid thereon, and he having awarded the Contract for the construction of said Sanitary sewers accordingly.

Be it Resolved by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction Colorado, that the awarding of the said Contract. For Construction of said Sanitary Sewer in and for District No. 1 to The Geddiss and Beris Stone Co. by the Mayor, be and the same is hereby approved by the City Council. The Mayor made report in writing of securing bids and awarding Contract on Sewer Dist. # 1. See page 255. Alderman Labory moved the adoption of the following Resolution: Whereas the Mayor of this City has advertised

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for bids for the construction of sanitary sewers in Sewer District No. 2. of the city of Grand Junction as per Ordinance No 91. and has publicly received and accepted the same and has found that the bid of The Geddis and Series Stone Co. for the sum of \$40596.⁶³/₁₀₀ is the lowest responsible bid thereon, and he having awarded the contract for the construction of said sanitary sewer accordingly, subject to the approval of the City Council.

Be it Resolved by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, that the awarding of the said Contract for construction of said sanitary sewer in and for District No. 2. to The Geddis & Series Stone Co. by the Mayor, be and the same is hereby approved by the City Council. upon motion by alderman McKinney City Atty was instructed to prepare contract for parties who have given right of way: across lot 13. Block 12. Mobleys addition. The application of Garrison and Fletcher was received for a Plumbers License for one year from date of issue with Bond \$1000. signed by Garrison and Fletcher Geo. R. Garrison. Geo. Fletcher and Alva Deeg Miller

upon motion the Bonds was accepted and license was granted by the following vote. Covy yea. Bronner yea. Ramey yea. Starr yea. Dickerson yea Whorton yea. McKinney yea. Smith yea.

a communication from D.R. Crosby offering to superintend construction of sewers for 6% of Contract Price was received and read

alderman Barry made motion and seconded by alderman Smith that the offer of D.R. Crosby be accepted. Alderman Whorton made motion to amend motion seconded by alderman Ramey that same be referred to Committee on Sewers. The roll was called and the vote was as follows. Covy. Nay. Bronner Nay Ramey yea. Starr Nay. Dickerson yea. Whorton yea McKinney Nay. Smith Nay. Lost

The roll was called upon original motion and vote was as follows. Covy yea. Bronner yea. Ramey Nay Starr yea. Dickerson yea. Whorton not voting McKinney yea Smith yea. carried.

upon motion by alderman Covy City Atty was instructed to draw up Contract for superintend of Sewer

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Construction between S. R. Crosby and City and
the Mayor and City Council create same and part of the City
upon motion by Alderman Dickerson and seconded
by Alderman Starr City Clerk was instructed to draw
a warrant for \$ 71.60 to pay freight on Road
grader by the following vote: Every year. Brunner year
Raney year. Starr year. Dickerson year. Whorton year
McKinley year. Smith year.
upon motion by Alderman Brunner the Salary
Ordinance was taken up and considered
Alderman McKinley made motion and seconded
by Alderman Starr that Salary Ordinance # 93. be
placed upon its passage and be adopted. The roll
was called and the vote was as follows. Every year
Brunner year. Raney year. Starr year. Dickerson year
Whorton year. McKinley year. Smith year.
Ordinance # 93 was ^{read} passed and adopted.
Ordinance pertaining to annual appropriation was
taken up and considered.

I have the honor to report to your Honorable body
that under and in accordance with the terms and
provisions of Ordinance No. 90, creating Sewer District No. 7 and authorizing
and ordering the construction of sanitary sewers therein, I did
advertise for bids for the construction of said sanitary sewers
as required by law, the said bids to be received by me and
publicly opened and announced on Monday evening
March 12th 1900 at the hour of 8 o'clock P. M.

That at said time I did receive all bids submitted and open
and publicly announce the same.

The Geddip and Greer Stone Co	\$ 12,134.07

That the Geddip and Greer Stone Co being the lowest
responsible bid for the construction of said Sanitary Sewer
for said District, the contract therefor was accordingly
awarded to it, subject to the approval of the
City Council as the law directs.
