Resolved, that the City Clerk be instructed
 to sign and seal a notice in the following form, to-wit:
 To The Grand Junction Water Company, and
 to all whom it may concern:

This is to notify you that the City of
 Grand Junction, has erected, and is now owning
 and operating, and for a long time prior hereto has
 owned and operated a system of waterworks, including
 a system of pumps, pipes, mains, fire hydrants etc. with
 which it supplies all its needs of water for fire protection
 or other purposes; and that it is not using, and has
 not for a long time hereto used, and does not intend
 to use any fire-hydrants, pipes, mains, pumps, or water-
 works or parts thereof, belonging to any other system or
 works, except its own above mentioned; nor does it use
 or obtain nor for a long time prior hereto has it
 used or obtained, nor does it intend to use or obtain
 any water from any other source or system than its
 own, for any purposes whatever.

 the City of Grand Junction, by order of the City Council
 of said City, this Seventeenth (17) Day of April, 1900

at once serve a copy of said notice upon the manager of The Grand Junction Water Company, also to publish a copy thereof, and further to spread a copy of said notice on the records of said city, together with the proof of service thereof as above required.
