Moved and seconded that ^{for} Mr. Rider be allowed to address the Council on the subject of lime Carried

Moved by Broemser and seconded by Wharton. That the matter of purchasing ~~lime~~ be referred to the purchasing committee with power to act. Ald. Barton yea, Broemser yea, Lovey yea, Dickerson yea, Lee yea Shores yea, Smith yea Wharton yea. Carried

Moved by Barton and seconded by Smith That the matter of securing old sewer pipe for boxes for crossings be referred to the purchasing committee and they report next meeting Carried

Moved by Barton and seconded by Lee that the Clerk be instructed to inform the contractor of the Water Works to settle all pipe lines along the new system of work. Carried

Moved by Barton and seconded by Lovey that Mr. Stull be given permission to address the Council Carried

Moved by Barton and seconded by Dickerson That the matter of new connections to the water works

be referred to the Water Works Committee Carried
 Moved by Wharton and seconded by Dickerson
 that Mr. L.M. White be hired to run the water through
 the streets and that he have nothing to do with the Park
 at \$30.00 per month. at the discretion of the Council. Ald.

Moved and seconded that Mrs. Gate be
 given permission to address the Council. Carried

Moved by Lovey and seconded by Dickerson
 that the Water Works Committee look up the
 matter of building a house for the pumpman at the
 water work and report next meeting. Carried

Moved by Dickerson and seconded by Broenzer
 that the Janitor be allowed \$10.00 a month more for
 his services as driver of the fire team in addition to
 his salary as Janitor. Ald Barton yea Broenzer yea,
 Lovey yea, Dickerson yea. Lee yea Shores yea Smith yea
 Wharton yea. Carried

Moved by Broenzer and seconded by Lovey.
 That the Driver, Sullivan be allowed to take the
 work team to his home to take care of. Carried.

Moved by Wharton and seconded Dickerson
 that the City Attorney be instructed to proceed against
 the Grand Junction Water Co. to collect cost of cases
 dropped in the Courts. Carried

Ald. Barton introduced the following
 resolution Whereas in the opinion of a two-thirds majority
 of the City Council it is deemed necessary that a new
 side walk be constructed along and in front of lots
 six and seven, block 123. South side of 4th Ave., Lot 4 in Block
 7 Mobley addition South side main St. Owned by M. F. Allison
 and L. W. Shores respectively. Therefore be it
 ordered that a side walk such as provided for by ordi-
 nance except that it be six feet wide instead of twelve feet
 wide be constructed by the owners of said property along
 and in front of the said lots under the provisions and
 ordinance made and provided. Ald Barton Moved the
 adoption of the fore going resolution which motion was
 seconded by Wharton. The yeas and nays being called
 the vote resulted as follows, Ald Barton yea Broenzer yea
 Lovey yea, Dickerson yea. Lee yea Shores yea Smith yea
 Wharton yea Carried.
