Adjourned meeting of the City Council  
Mayor Cla in the chair upon roll call the  
following aldermen responded Barton Lovey  
Dickerson Smith and Wharton. Absent Bohem-  
ser Lu and Shous.

Moved and seconded we suspend the  
regular order of business and take up sewer  
matter carried

Moved by Wharton and seconded by  
Dickerson we give the publication for the sale  
of sewer bonds to the Evening Sun. A vote  
was then taken which resulted as follows  
Barton voted yes Lovey yea Dickerson yea Smith  
yes Wharton yes carried



The following resolutions were read by Alderman Smith who moved their adoption which was seconded by Alderman Mowey.

Sewer District Number One of the City of Grand Junction, Colo.

Approving First Estimate

Adopted June 13, 1900

Whereas, in and by the contract heretofore awarded for the construction of the improvements in Sanitary Sewer District Number One of the City of Grand Junction Colo. it is provided that payment for said improvements shall be made to the contractor in public improvement bonds or warrants of said City drawn upon the fund of said district in monthly installments of ninety per cent of all moneys due for work done during the preceding month under and in accordance with the provisions and stipulations of said contract, based upon monthly estimates of work completed and certified to by the engineer and approved by the City Council; And

Whereas, the engineer has made and filed in the office of the City Clerk his first estimate of the work completed in said district to the 12 day of June A.D. 1900 in the sum of 11,922.47 Therefore

Resolved, by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction Colorado, that said estimate should be and the same is hereby approved; and the City Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to issue to the contractor the public improvement bonds aforesaid to the amount of \$10,500<sup>00</sup> the same being approximately ninety per cent. of the amount accrued upon said estimate, said bonds so to be delivered to be of the following numbers and dimensions respectively, to wit

Bonds numbers 16 to 36 both inclusive, (21 bonds), for the sum of \$100 <sup>00</sup> each	\$10,500 <sup>00</sup>
Total, (21 bonds),	\$10,500 <sup>00</sup>

For which bonds when issued the contractor shall give the Treasurer a good and sufficient receipt.

Sewer District Number Two of the City of Grand Junction Colo

Approving first Estimate

Adopted June 13 1900

Whereas, in and by the contract heretofore awarded for the construction of the improvements in Sanitary Sewer District Number Two of the City of Grand Junction Colorado, it is provided



that payment for said improvements shall be made to the contractor in public improvement bonds or warrants of said city drawn upon the fund of said district in monthly installments of ninety per cent. of all moneys due for work done during the preceding month under and in accordance with the provisions and stipulations of said contract, based upon monthly estimates of work completed and certified to by the engineer and approved by the city council, and

Whereas the engineer has made and filed in the office of the city clerk his first estimate of the work completed in said district to the 12 day of June a.d. 1900 in the sum of \$19,389.22 therefore

Resolved by the city council of the city of Grand Junction Colorado, that said estimate should be and the same is hereby approved, and the City Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to issue to the contractor the public improvement bonds aforesaid to the amount of \$17,000.00 the same being approximately ninety per cent. of the amount accrued upon said estimate, said bonds so to be delivered to be of the following numbers and dimensions respectively, to wit:

Bonds numbers 29 to 45 both inclusive. (17 bonds), for the sum of \$1,000. each \$17,000.00  
 Total (17 bonds), \$17,000.00

For which bonds when issued the contractor shall give the treasurer a good and sufficient receipt.
