Moved and seconded the Clerk inform Mr. H. Emanuel that the City of Grand Junction doesn't want to make a contract with him for a pump. Carried

Moved by Barton and seconded by Lovey that the City Attorney be instructed to draw up a contract with Mr. W. Renicker for hauling coal to the City pump house at 55¢ per ton from this date to April 1 1901. A vote being taken on the foregoing motion the results were as follows
