Moved by Barton and Seconded by Broemser That the Mayor appoint a committee of one, with to go to Denver to investigate the purchase of a pump and also confer with M. S. Allison, that they make the best selection under the circumstances and if a pump is purchased it be under the specification of the Worthington pump contract.

Amendment offered by Lovey and seconded by Dickerson. That the committee be two instead of one. A vote being taken on the amendment, it resulted as follows: Al. Moved by Barton and seconded by Broemser That the matter of deeding two lots on Sixth and Eleventh Ave. to Public Library Committee be referred to the City attorney. Carried

Moved by Lovey and seconded Broemser That a warrant be drawn in favor of The Giddis Lurie Stone Co for \$3,339.17, as one half of the 5% reserve on water works contract, due at the expiration of three months from completion. A vote being taken the results were as follows: Barton Nay, Broemser yes Lovey yes Dickerson yes Lee nay Shores nay, Smith yes Wharton yes. Carried

Moved and seconded That Mr White be notified and once to comply more strictly with his contract for running the water through the ditches, in the future, or it will be rescinded. A vote was then taken which resulted as follows: Barton nay Broemser yes, Lovey nay Dickerson yes Lee yes Shores yes Smith nay, Wharton yes. Carried.

Moved and seconded Mrs Yates be allowed to address the Council Carried.
