

Grand Junction Colo.

May 28, 1900

Adjourned meeting of the City Council, Mayor Cla in the Chair. Upon roll call the following Aldermen responded Barton Broemser, Covey, Dickerson, Lee, Smith, Wharton. Absent Shaw. Minutes of previous meeting read and approved with corrections.

Moved by Broemser and seconded by Barton that the rules be suspended and the matter of pumpman be taken up. Carried.

Moved and seconded that the resignation of John Tracer as pumpman be accepted and placed on file. Carried.

The following applications for the position of pumpman were then read.

- D. J. Hare      Ricd three votes
- N. L. Guinan   Ricd five votes and declared Elected
- T. A. Snook.

Moved and seconded in ballot on pumpman Carried.

Moved and seconded that the Clerk notify Mr. Guinan and Superintendent of Water works at once of the <sup>results</sup> Carried.

Moved and seconded that the petition of Carrie Spright and six others for new sidewalk be referred to the street and alley Com. Carried.

Moved by Covey and seconded by Dickerson that the Clerk be instructed to draw a warrant for \$1.90 on the proper fund for the recording of the deed to the right of way of water line. Upon roll call the vote was as follows: Ald Barton yea Broemser yea Covey yea Dickerson yea Lee yea Smith yea Wharton yea Carried.

Moved by Barton and seconded by Broemser that the Mayor and Clerk sign up the contract with B. R. Lewis for the erection of a residence at the pump house according to his bid of May 14, 1900 for 410 in City Warrants, the house to be above the track and he to start to work at once under the direction of the Water and Sewer Com. A vote being taken the results were as follows: Ald Barton yea Broemser yea Covey yea Dickerson yea Lee yea Smith yea Wharton yea. Carried.

Moved and seconded that Mr. J. W. Bowers be allowed to address the Council upon the matter of a donation for Memorial exercises. Carried.

It is the sense of the City Council that the request of Mr. J. W. Bowers for twenty five dollars for memorial day exercise be granted if the funds were on hand.

Moved and Seconded that Dr Clark be allowed to address the Council on the subject of holding Adventist meetings in the City park Carried

Moved by Levey and Seconded by Smith, That the Adventist be allowed to use the park for revival meetings and that Mr Clark be held responsible for any damage done Carried

Moved by Levey and Seconded by Dickerson That the Clerk inform the City Engineer to make estimates and measurements of pipe for connections with the flush tanks and water mains and report at next meeting Carried

Moved and Seconded we adjourn until Monday Night June 4 at 8 P.M. 1900 Carried
