Moved and seconded that the petition for new side walk on North 5th street be referred to Street and alley committee. Carried

Moved by Orharton and seconded by Broemser that the report of J. D. Reeder as Superintendent of the Water Works be accepted and placed on file. Carried

Moved by Smith and seconded by Broemser that a license be granted Campbell Bros Circus to show on May 31 1900 for Twenty five dollars.

That the bids for the erection and construction of a residence
at the Pumping station for the pump may be opened. Carried

station be awarded to B. R. Lurrie in accordance
with his bid, received May 14 1900. Upon Roll

Moved by Lovey and seconded by Lee
That upon the proper board being filled, that
the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized to sign a
contract with B. R. Lurrie for the erection of a
residence at the Pumping Station. Carried

referred to the finance com. Carried

Moved and seconded that the bill of G
W Swain for fence post, for 18⁰⁰ be allowed and
warrant drawn for same. Upon Roll call the vote

Moved and seconded that the bill of
O'Neil & Thomas be referred to the City Attorney
Carried

Moved by Broemser and seconded by

injuries and expenses from running a road
through her foot on an over turned side walk
on Chepeta Ave, be referred to the City Attorney. Carried

of Wm Lee & Son for Prushes for 3⁷² and Truman H.
Vetchum for dog tax and stamps for 4⁹⁵ be allowed

Moved and seconded that Mr Yetter
be allowed to address the Council upon the matter of
a pump. Carried
