Shores, Wharton. Absent, Broemser, Levey, Smith.
Minutes of April 30 and May 1 read

Moved by Barton and seconded by Wharton
That the request of the Fire Department be granted
and that the name of Geo R. Garrison as Chief of the
Fire Department be accepted and confirmed, to
fill the vacancy of Frank Sullivan resigned
Carried

Moved and seconded that the report of
the City Marshall be accepted and placed on
file carried

Moved by Barton and seconded by Dickerson
That the hitching posts which were taken out
during the grading and clearing of the streets, be replaced
under the direction of the Street Commissioner Carried

Moved by Barton and seconded by Lee
That the street and ally committee investigate
the cost of leasing two lots adjoining the present
two owned by the city on the corner of Sixth street and
Colo. Ave. the same to be used for hitching place
and market grounds. Carried.

Moved by Barton and seconded by
Dickerson That the Superintendent of the Water Works
be instructed to connect the fountains with the city
water works, if found belonging to the city, under
the instructions of the Water Works Com. Ald. Barton
yea, Dickerson yea, Lee, yea, Shores yea, Wharton yea.
Carried

Moved by Barton and seconded by Lee. That
the Superintendent of the water works be instructed to
make contract with the Indian School to furnish

water to them for \$1/2¢ per one hundred gallons
 Ald Barton yea Dickerson yea Lee yea Shores yea
 Wharton yea. Carried.

Moved by Barton and seconded by Lee
 that anyone out side of the city limits should be
 furnished water at the schudual of the Grand
 Junction water co. Barton yea Dickerson yea
 Lee yea Shores yea Wharton yea. Carried

Moved by Barton and seconded by Wharton
 That the Board of ME Barton as Janitor of the City
 Hall. be accepted and approved. Carried

Moved and seconded That all new
 bills be refered to the finance com. Carried

Moved by Wharton and seconded.
 That the bill of R. N. Burkhart be allowed and
 a warrant drawn for same for \$10⁰⁰ Ald.
 Barton yea Dickerson yea Lee yea, Shores yea Wharton
 yea. Carried.
