Public Notice of Sale of Sewer Bonds.  
Grand Junction, Colorado.  
In pursuance and by virtue of a certain reso-  
lution of the City Council of the City of Grand  
Junction, Colorado, passed and adopted June  
15, 1900, I, W. P. Elia, Mayor of said City, will  
on Thursday, the fifth day of July, A. D. 1900,  
at the hour of two o'clock P. M., at the Mesa  
County State Bank, in the City of Grand Jun-  
ction, in the County of Mesa and State of Colo-  
rado, expose for sale and sell to the highest  
and best bidder for cash, at not less than their  
par value, the following described and number-  
ed Sewer Bonds, namely:  
Three bonds of Sewer District No. 1 of said  
city, numbered one (1), two (2) and thirty-eight  
(38), of the par value of \$100.00, \$100.00 and \$500.00  
respectively.  
Also three bonds of Sewer District No. 2 of  
said City, numbered thirteen (13), forty-seven  
(47) and forty-eight (48), of the par value of  
\$500.00, \$1000.00 and \$1000.00 respectively.  
Under the provisions of Section 35 of the Act  
of the General Assembly of the State of Colo-  
rado, approved April 8, 1899.

Moved by Barton and seconded by Lee that the lease of the D. & R. G. R. R. lcs for ground to erect a pump house dwelling on be referred to the City attorney and if found proper, The Mayor and Clerk to sign same, and further the Clerk procure the necessary stamps. A vote was then taken which resulted as follows. Barton voted yea Broemser yea Lovey yea Dickerson yea Lee yea Shores yea Smith yea Wharton yea Carried

The following resolution was read by Alderman Wharton who moved its adoption which was seconded by Alderman Barton

Be it resolved that until the further action of the City Council, the City shall and will furnish to all churches, hospitals, public schools and all charitable institutions in said City, water from its water works system free of all charge.

A vote being taken upon the foregoing resolution was as follows. Alderman Barton voted yea Broemser yea, Lovey, yea Dickerson yea Lee yea Shores yea Smith yea Wharton yea Carried

Moved and seconded that the Street Commissioners wheel be returned to him for use. A vote was taken which resulted as follows. Barton voted yea Broemser yea Lovey yea Dickerson yea Lee yea Shores yea Smith yea Wharton yea Carried

Moved and seconded that Mr A R Sampliner be allowed to address the Council upon the extension of water mains. Carried

Moved and seconded that Mr J M Sampliner be allowed to address the Council upon the subject of a donation for Peach Day. Carried

Moved and seconded that the matter of a donation for Peach Day be referred to the City Attorney to report at next meeting. Carried

Moved and seconded that Mr W A Marsh be allowed to address the Council upon the subject of dumping sewerage into the river and in behalf of the residents living below the city carried.

Moved and seconded the matter of dumping sewerage into the river be referred to the City Attorney and sewer and water committee to investigate. Carried

Moved and seconded we adjourn until tomorrow night July 11 at 8 P M 1900
