

Grand Junction Colo
Aug 30 1900

Adjourned meeting of the City Council. Mayor Cla in the chair. When Roll call the following aldermen responded. Barton Broemser Lovey Dickerson Lee Shores Smith and Wharton.

Minutes of Aug 14 read and approved.

Moved and seconded. That the City extend the water mains on Hill and 4th Street and that we purchase and lay about 800 feet of water pipe, with the understanding that Community dig trench and refill same, under the supervision of the Water Com. A vote was taken which was as follows. Barton voted yea Broemser yea Lovey yea Dickerson yea Lee yea Shores yea Smith yea Wharton yea. Carried

Moved and seconded. That the work at the pump house of erecting a pier and setting new pump, be referred to the Water Committee with power to act. A vote was taken which was as follows. Barton voted yea Broemser yea Lovey yea Dickerson yea Lee yea Shores yea Smith yea Wharton yea. Carried

Moved and seconded. That W.A. Marsh be instructed to inform the Petitioners, he represented who live below the City. That the City will deliver the water to the City limit and that the cost ^{of delivering water} will be the same as that paid by others outside the City, namely the same rate charged by the Grand Junction Water Company. A vote was taken which was as follows. Barton voted yea Broemser yea Lovey yea Dickerson yea Lee yea Shores yea Smith yea Wharton yea. Carried

Alderman Lovey then introduced a resolution which was as follows and moved its adoption which was seconded by Ald Wharton.

"Whereas in the opinion of a two thirds majority of the City Council, it is necessary that a sidewalk be constructed on the North side of West Main Street in front of lots No. 1 to 11 inclusive in Block 6 of Richard D. Mobley's first sub. division to the town of Grand Junction also on the east side of Spruce Street and in front and along the west side of Lot 11 in said Block 6; also on the North north side of West Main Street in front and along the north side of Lot 4 Block 7 of said sub division also the south side of Ross Ave in front of lots 1 to 10 inclusive in Block 104 in the City of Grand Junction also on the south side of Main in front of lots 1 to 16 inclusive in Block 114 in said City of

Grand Junction

Therefore be it ordered that a side walk such as provided by ordinance save that it be six feet instead of 12. be constructed along and in front of said above described lots under the provisions of the statute and ordinance concerning side walk in such cases made and provided. And whereas in the opinion of said City Council it is further deemed necessary that a new ^{side} walk be constructed on the south side of Holo Ave in front of lots 5, 6, 7 and 11 in Block 133 of said City. Therefore be it further ordered that a new side walk such as provided by ordinance save and except that it be 8 feet wide instead of 12 be constructed along and in front of said last above described lots under the provisions of statute and ordinance made and provided in such cases. A vote was taken upon the foregoing resolution which resulted as follows Barton voted yea Broemser yea Covey yea Dickerson yea Lee yea Shores yea Smith yea Wharton yea Leppard.

Moved and seconded that the Street Commissioners be ordered to repair all side walks and crossings that needed same. A vote was taken which was as follows Ald. Barton voted yea Broemser yea Covey yea Dickerson yea Lee yea Shores yea Smith yea Wharton yea Leppard.

Adopted Aug 20 1900
 Whereas, in and by the contract heretofore awarded for the construction of the improvements in sanitary sewer District No. 2 of the City of Grand Junction Colorado, it is provided that payment for said improvements shall be made to the contractor in public improvement bonds or warrents of said city drawn upon the fund of said district in monthly installments of ninety per cent. of all moneys due for work done during the preceding month under and in accordance with the provisions and stipulations of said contract, based upon monthly estimates of work completed and certified to by the Engineer and approved by the City Council, and

Whereas, the Engineer has made and filed in the office of the City Clerk his second estimate

of the work completed in said district to the 10 day of July a/c. 1900 in the sum of \$7349 ²⁶ Therefore Resolved, by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, that said estimate should be and the same is here by approved and the City Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to issue to the Contractor, the public improvement bonds aforesaid to the amount of \$7,000⁰⁰ the same being approximately ninety per cent. of the amount accrued upon said estimate, said Bonds so to be delivered to be of the following numbers and dimensions respectively.
